Message from FCLOA's Vice President

My wife and I have lived in Arrowbee Ranch Estates for about 25 years now. Wild fires used to be something that happened somewhere else, usually in remote areas.

Now I spend most of the summer on edge wondering if the moment is going to come that there is a wild fire here in our neighborhood and we will need to evacuate.

We had some real close calls in 2023. CalFire used our lake to extinguish several fires within just a few miles of our homes.

The FCLOA board is working hard to improve fire safety in Arrowbee.

- Worked with the Coloma Lotus Fire Safe Council to become a recognized Firewise Community
- Working with the Rescue FD to get Station 84 open 24/7.
- Installing fire equipment apparatus at the park to provide a reliable and easy water source for firefighters.

It would help us if everyone would pay their dues. The less time we spend on dues collection, the more time we have for fire safety.

It is comforting to see the improvements happening throughout the neighborhood with people clearing brush, thinning canopies, and fire hardening their homes.

Nothing will ever make where we live "fireproof," but every bit of fuel that is no longer surrounding us will make a fire less intense, spread slower, and allow for firefighting to be more successful.

Clearing around homes is great for improving your odds. Please also:

- Create fire breaks to separate large fields of dry brush.
- Clear along the roadway of your property.
- Clear all dry grass that can ignite the canopy above.

Installing Fire Tanker Fill Apparatus at the Park

One way your dues are contributing to fire safety is the installation of equipment at the park so that firefighters have an easily accessible hook-up to access lake water. As you know, there are very few fire hydrants in our neighborhood. Installing this equipment will improve reaction time, efficiency and effectiveness of fighting fires within Arrowbee. The equipment will be locked up to protect against vandalism, but readily accessible by our firefighters.
